Average Fahrenheit temperatures in early September are a high of 83, and a low of 57.

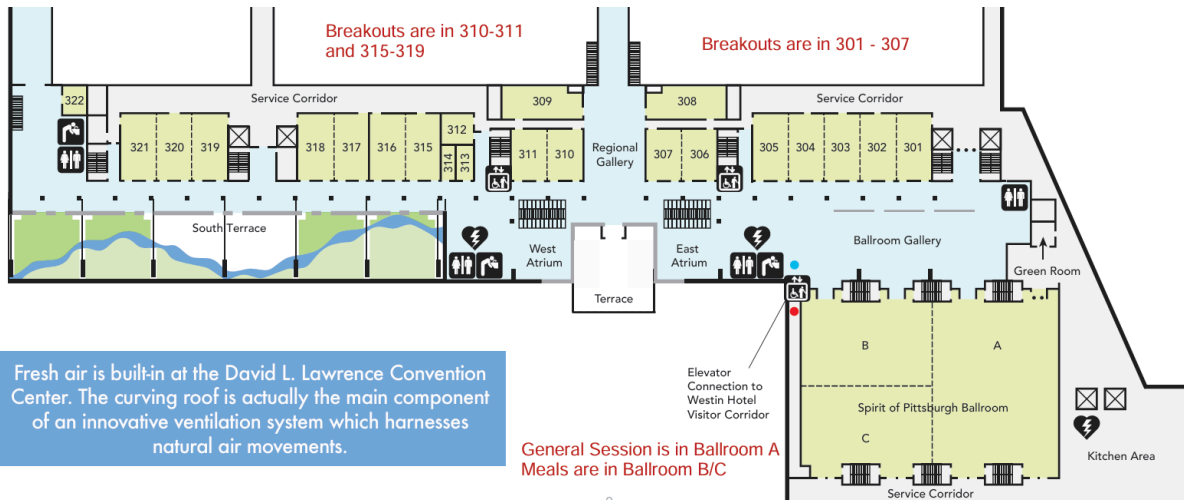
Time Zone
